The Strathbungo Society has come a long way since the original group was set up to promote a small Conservation Area back in the early 1970s. Today, it takes in around 1,000 households between Nithsdale Drive and Titwood Road, and while still committed to our fine architectural heritage, the Society's aims have also reached out to cover local amenities, environmental improvements, social events - in short, everything to do with living in one of Glasgow's most vibrant communities.

We are always grateful to those who volunteer to help out - and indeed, to those who turn up and support our events. Even so, not everybody has the time or opportunity to play an active role. That's why we've set up Friends of Strathbungo.

Here's how it works

As a Friend of Strathbungo, you agree to pay an annual subscription of £12 – just £1 a month – preferably by using the standing order mandate in this leaflet. You may decide to pay your subscription either once (£12) or twice (£6) a year or pledge a higher amount, if you wish.

If you live within the Society's boundaries, your Friends membership card will entitle you to vote at the Society's Annual General Meeting each June. If you live outside the area, you will receive the Strathbungo News by post, along with news of special events or offers.

Here's why we need all the Friends we can get

As a community-based charity, the Strathbungo Society represents local residents' viewpoints and interests to the powers that be, including government officials in planning, cleansing and environmental health, as well as the Police. We campaign for better local amenities, from shopping to transport to facilities at Queens Park. We also work to secure outside support and funding for major projects, such as back lanes renovation.

But it's not all just worthy endeavour!

The Strathbungo Society brings local people together through a year-round calendar of events and communications:

- **Strathbungo News**, a regular round-up of local news, features and opinion
- **Bungo at the Bells**, the annual street party on Hogmanay
- **Bungo in the Back Lanes**, the mid-summer gala
- Ad hoc meetings in response to community issues – from election eve hustings to crime prevention workshops
- Occasional events such as coffee mornings, Hallowe'en parties, ceilidhs, heritage walks – *just for the fun of it!*
